Madsen would like the services of freshman Kerri Hughes, who is out with a hip injury right now. He expects her back sometime in October.

Meanwhile, the Hornettes are sporting more power than last year. They already have improved a place in each invitational. Madsen hopes the team will perform well at Reavis, where it finished fifth last year.

"The girls like to run that meet," he said.
"They give a lot of medals and trophies.
That's a good incentive. We'd like to get a trophy."

On Monday, Sept. 19, South will have its first conference meet against Addison Trail and Riverside-Brookfield at Katherine Legge Park.

# Freshman sparks

## South girl runners

Hinsdale South's girls' cross country team will be out to get all the hardware it can when it competes in the largest meet of the season at Niles West.

Some 35 girls' teams will compete in the meet, which will be split into two divisions. Last year the Hornettes finished fifth and brought home a brophy.

While he was looking forward to the Niles meet, South coach Mike Madsen was still talking about the Hornettes' third-place finish last week at the Bloom Invitational.

South finished with 68 points but was only seven points behind St. Ignatius and 10 points behind winner Thornridge, which placed seventh at state last year.

"I didn't expect us to be so close to Thornridge; they are a very powerful team," [Madsen said. "We were battling with St. Ignatius throughout the race."

"She ran extremely well," Madsen said of Faber, normally the fourth or fifth runner. "It was the best any freshman has run at this meet."

Faber even outran veterans Karyn Verdak (11th, 14:03) and Sally Kurth (16th, 14:09.8).

"She's now getting to the point where she

relaxes and runs to her ability," Madsen said of Faber.

Meanwhile, senior Eileen Slowikowskilost her showdown with Bloomington's Melissa Straza, the defending distance champion in track. Straza outran Slowikowski 12:10 to 12:56.

"Eileen ran strong throughout the race, but Straza was just awesome," Madsen said. "She was just too fast, even for Fileen."

Finishing out for the Hornettes were Sandy Placek (29th, 14:40.1); Diane Sly (49th, 15:40.5); and Linda Schluter (68th, 16:28.6). In the open race, no team scores were

its runners in the top 20. Finishing for finisdale were Mary Schuch (12th, 15:43); Jackie Smalley (16th, 15:57); Pat Barrera (18th, 16:09); Nancy Seddon (19th, 16:10); Heather Wydra (20th, 16:16); and Carol Catinella (26th, 16:46).

### Like brother, like sister

#### Hinsdale S. pair have running in their blood

SEVEN YEARS have passed since Norbert Slowikowski brought his son, Ed, along for an early-morning jog in the park. The elder Slowikowski had enjoyed a successful running career at Loyola University, having clocked a 4:12 mile. Maybe his son would like distance running, too.

He did. Ed became somewhat of a legend at Cass Junior High in Darien, winning race after race. The person he influenced most by his success was his older sister, Eileen.

Today, Ed, a junior, and Eileen, a senior, run cross country and track at Hinsdale South High School. They form what could be the finest brother-sister running combination Illinois has ever seen.

"I always watched my brother run in junior high and loved it," Eileen said. "I admired him and wished I could do that, but I was too much of a baby to try it."

AS A FRESHMAN, Eileen got enough nerve to go out for track. The following fall, she dared to try out for cross country. Her rate of success zoomed right up with Ed's.

Two years ago, Eileen finished 16th in the state cross-country meet. Last year, Ed finished 22d, beating state favorite Doug Schroer of York with a strong finishing kick. At the state track meet, Eileen finished third in the 800-meter run for the second straight year, while Ed finished 13th in the 2-mile, breaking the school record with a 9:16.

"We try to help each other out," said Ed, who began this season with a victory at the Hinsdale Red Devil/Hornet Invitational moments after Eileen won the girls' race. They came close to pulling another double Sept. 24 at the Bloom Invitational, when Ed finished first and Eileen second. "We give each other advice, or try to cheer each other up by saying things we know the other one wants to hear.

THE DUO REALLY needed each other's support last

year, when they both encountered rare setbacks.

After winning the Lockport cross-country regional last.
October, Eileen ran the worst race of her life the following week at the Rich East sectional and failed to qualify for the state meet.

"It was the worst feeling I've ever had?" Eileen said.
"I psyched myself out. I started off fast, but when people started passing me, I panicked. My legs got so heavy, it felt like I couldn't move them. I even thought about dropping out of the race. After that I decided I was going to make it up to myself."

"We worked on overcoming that bad race, and she was her old self in track," said Hinsdale South girls' coach Mike Madsen. "She's an aggressive runner who likes to take the lead and stay there. Right now she's running the best she ever has in cross country.

ED'S MISFORTUNE took place last March at the prestigious Proviso West Classics With his dad in the stands, he finished last in the 2-mile.

My dad was really embarrassed," Ed recalled. "His college coach asked him if I was his son and he said, 'No, that's not him.' He's always joking and getting on me if I have a bad race.

At first glance, some people think it's a joke Ed is such a good runner. A year ago, he stood just 5 feet and weighed only 95 pounds. He shot up during the summer to 5-4 and 105 pounds.

"His size has never been a concern of mine because in distance running, the less weight you have to carry the better off you are," said Hinsdale South boys' coach Daye Jackson. "He may look small, but he's starting to

each morning and run to school.

Their parents then return to the breakfast table for one last cup of coffee and drive to work.

Erase that scene. It's not like that at ll. Here's the way it really is: Norb and Mary Jane Slowikowski, proponents of positive thinking, are up at dawn's early light, running at 6 a.m. to an occasional bark of a dog. When they return, Eileen is just getting up. Eddie? He has turned over for another 15 minutes of shuteye.

No. it's not until afternoon when Eileen and Eddie get into high gear. And when they do, watch out, world.

Eileen Slowikowski is the best female middle and distance runner South has had. Eddie Slowikowski is the best male distance runner. Each is on a team that has state aspirations, especially Eddie's, which is ranked fourth in the state.

In real life, Eileen and Eddie are op posites.

Eileen plays it straight in school. Eddie answers to Slackman "for my great ability to slack off." He was grounded for a weekend for being a "disruptive force" in the classroom. Nothing felonious, mind you Just

mischievous. Eileen ran throughout the summer, attending a cross-country camp at the University of Illinois.

Eddie put off his running until the end of summer.


Their only similarity on the course is getting out in front and staying there. Otherwise, Eileen runs scientifically and Eddie "just runs."

But don't think for one moment they don't like each other or that Eddie Slowikowski is a total goof-off. He may call himself "weird" and Eileen may agree, but everyone who has seen Eddie run knows the slight (100 pounds) but muscular (15 chin-ups with ease) young man is very talented, very determined and very much like his father.

Norb Slowikowski, you see, was running the mile for Loyola University in 4 minutes, 12 seconds back when 4:30 was considered fashionable. The desire to run forever burns within him and he's proudly has passed it down to his children, particularly Eddie.

"They tell me he was a great runner, and I have to believe them because he has all those medals," Eddie said.

"Unfortunately, I took some of them to school in the fourth grade and lost 'em.

"He's always on me about running. He got me started in the third grade. He didn't want me to ride the bus, so instead, I raced it. I'd wait until it started up, then I'd run to the next stop. I never won, but I came close a few times. My friends were in the bus cheering.
"Dad used to make me get up at 5:30 to

run with him in a park. He always beat me, and a lot of times I'd cry. But finally, in the fifth grade, I beat him. He was pretty mad.

"He comes to all our races. He's always honest. He tells me if I run a good race, and he lets me know when I run a dumb one

Most of the time Eddie Slowikowski runs smart. He goes out fast, but saves a little extra for opponents who sneak up to challenge. Then . . . whoosh! He's gone.

"I get too worried if I sit behind

people," he said.

He sat way behind people at the St.
Charles Invitational in early September, finishing 21st. He traced it to stomach cramps from drinking water on a humid day before the meet.

"I'll never do that again," he said. He has finished out of first place only once since.

Elleen's forte is the 800 meters in track. She was fourth in state as a sophomore and third as a junior.

But she never gives up in cross country, even though she has yet to beat last year's champ, Shelly McBride, and the brilliant Melissa Strasser, who won the mile and two-mile last spring as a

Perhaps if Eileen had started a little earlier .

"I always enjoyed watching my brother run cross country, but didn't try

it myself until my sophomore year."

Eddie interjected, "I kept getting on her about it. I didn't think it was fair that

I had to do it, but she didn't."

Eileen continued, "I like it a lot; I clicked with it right away.

She clicked, all right, finishing 16th in state that year. But a nightmare came her junior year when, after winning district and rounding the first turn of sectional in first place, she psyched herself right out of qualifying.

It was one of those nightmares we all

where we're running from something evil, but not getting anywhere.

'It was awful. People started passing me and I kept thinking, 'You're nervous . . . you're nervous.' Then I'd say, 'Oh, come on. You're not THAT nervous. You can catch up.' But I couldn't. My legs got really heavy. I wanted to drop out, but I wouldn't let myself. I got sick at the end of the race, then had to watch the awards ceremony. I watched people I'd beaten going to state, and I wasn't.
"Like I said, it was awful."

Eileen Slowikowski has grown a lot

since then. No more psych-outs.

Going to camp helped. She learned tactics, pacing, uphill training, proper foods and, perhaps most important, to think positively. As a reminder, she has a chart hanging from a bedroom wall. It's 10 do's and don'ts of cross country.

Now when Norb Slowikowski tells his offspring what they did and did not do during a race, they understand.
