Inexperienced harriers need work

Hinsdale South cross country coach Mike Madsen hopes his young harriers will learn quickly.

The squad starts the season at 4:30 p.m. Thursday, Sept. 3, when it runs against Downers Grove South.

"We really don't have much experience on this team," Madsen said, "If we can stay healthy, we can be competitive. I feel it will take time, but this will be more like a rebuilding year for us."

Starting the season off against Downers South, the defending Gold Division champs of the West Suburban Conference, will be a stern test for the Hornettes.

The Mustangs have won the conference the last four years. "I have to be honest with you; we aren't ready to face that type of competition yet." Madsen said. "I'm not counting on much, but you have to face the best if you are to improve."

At 9:30 a.m. the Hornette harriers will help host the Hornet/Red Devil Invitational at Katherine Legge Memorial Park. Two tough meets in a row should give Madsen a clue as to how his season will go.

"So far in practice the kids have worked very hard," Madsen said. "We still have a long way to go, but maybe I'll be surprised."

Madsen is counting on two runners in particular, senior Rachel Doepke and junior Cindy Scheithoff, to add experience to the team. Doepke is the captain of the squad. Both ran quite a bit last year. Rachel ¡Doepke] has had some trouble with injuries, but if she stays healthy there is no teiling how good she can be."

Other runners Madsen will be looking at are seniors Sherry Hovorka, Dawn Kristola and Patty Wojtala. Juniors will be Jami Morris and Dana Pokorny. Sophomore Kali Kordewick and freshimen in Helga Dusek and Kristen Lasica are runners who will try to crack the top seven in the Hornette Lineup.

"Actually I've got more seniors than usual, considering I lost quite a few to graduation last year, but they lack experience." Madsen said. "I hope they will show good leadership."

As the season progresses Madsen would like to see his team improve. "If I can see us developing each time out, that would be good. In the past few seasons we have had the injury bug hit us, so I'm keeping my fingers crossed that it doesn't happen this vear," Madsen said.


Madsen is just hooing his team can stay importants. If leel we can place in the top

Morris top Hornette runner at invitational

Jamie Morris was the top runner for the Hinsdale South girls' cross country team. She helped pace the harriers to a sixth-place finish at the Hornet/Red Devil Invitational last weekend.

Morris was the first Hornette runner to cross the finish line in 21st place in a time of 13:48. The Hornettes as a team finished with 156 points. Naperville Central won with 28 points, and Hinsdale Central was second with 52 points.

Earlier last week the Hornette harriers lost a dual meet to Downers Grove South 15-43. In both meets the Hornettes were without Rachel Doepke, their top runner

last year. Doepke hurt the same ankle she had trouble with last season. "We don't know when she will return, but no doubt it hurt us not having her for either contest," Coach Mike Madsen said.

Only one contest is on the schedule this week for the Hornettes, and that is at 9:30 a.m. Saturday, Sept. 12, at the Reavis Invitational. At 4:30 p.m. Monday, Sept. 14, the Hornettes will travel to Addison Trail.

"When you look at our scores, they don't seem good, but compared to last year for these same two meets, they were about the same," Madsen said. "One good thing is that we are staying close as a pack. At the invitational we had six girls within a minute of each other."


Other girls placed at the invitational. Down Kristola finished 23th in 14:10. Cindy Schelthoff was 32nd in 14:31, Sherry Hovorka was 35th in 14:40, Helga Dusek was 39th in 14:44, Kali Kordewick was 42nd in 14:46, and Kristen Lasica placed 57th in 16:53.

"The big thing we have to work on is our times," Madsen said. "Since we have a young team, it is going to take a while to get them into the kind of shape needed to produce good times."

In the dual meet loss to Downers South, Morris again was the first to cross the finish line. She placed sixth in 13:56. Kristola was seventh in 14:07, Dusek was ninth in 14:32, Schelthoff was 10th in 14:42. Hovorka was 11th in 15:06, Lasica was 12th in 15:09, Kordewick was 13th in 15:10, and Pokorny was 14th in 15:14.

"What we need to do is pick up our times and still stay close as a pack," Madsen said. "What we're doing now should help us in the conference meets, but we'll need to pick it up if we are to do better in other meets."

In the 1st 2 meets, the Hornets have had difficulty placing near the top, but without their top runner Rachel Doepke, who is injured, this could be expected.

Hornets come back


Hinsdale South had the first 11 finishers in Tuesday's 15-50 triumph over Addison Trail.

injuries aside

Rachel Doepke was scared when the cross country season started this fall. She had hurt her ankle again. Memories of her junior year went through her mind.

Doepke, who runs both cross country and track for Hinsdale South, had missed almost her entire junior year with a damaged ligament in her ankle, and the prospect of missing another season was too much to bear.

"I was scared to death," Doepke said. "All I could think about was that it wasn't going to heal. I'm just so happy that the ankle has responded so far."

Dopke is a very important cog in the Hornet scheme of things. She was named all-conference last year even though she missed much of the season. When healthy, she is by far the best runner South has. She currently holds the eighth fastest time recorded at Katherine Legge Memorial Park, the Hornets' home course.

This year she is the captain of a very young Hornet squad. Even though she has had to battle her ankle problems, the senior runner wouldn't think of giving up the sport.

"People think I'm crazy to keep running," Doepke said. "But I enjoy running. I love to run in the pack."

For four years now Doepke has been running cross country. Her Coach Mike Madsen wasn't so sure she would last that long.

"She looked awful as a runner her freshman year." Madsen said. "She din't have that classic runners' build, but she has made herself a good runner and has shown the abily to bounce back. So far this year she has looked strong."

Doepke credits Madsen for getting her interested in cross country, "Coach was my earth science teacher. He kept encouraging me to run and was the only one to snow much of an interest in me. I will never regret making the decision to run."

During her freshman year Doepke had all to do to run one lap without getting tired. "Actually I went out for cross country because I wanted to lose weight," Doepke said. "But I kept at it because I saw myself improving. Now I have more endurance."

Always the hard worker, Doepke took this summer off to heal her ankle. The previous summer she had run quite a bit during the off season.

"I didn't run because the doctor told me to keep from putting too much pressure on the ankle," Doepke said. "Unfortunately I feel I lost my edge by doing that."

Madsen likes the fact that Doepke is a hard worker. "She is a very determined runner," Madsen said. "She puts in long hours not only at school but away from school with the job she has."

When Doepke is running, you can bet she will be leading the pack.

"She has started to pull away from the pack." Madsen said. "Before the pack was

close to her, but now she is starting to become a real leader for us."

Leading the pack is nice, but Doepke would like to be pushed more. On Monday she came in first in a dual meet with Leyden, but for the most part she was all alone on the course.

"I didn't see a soul," Doepke said. "It is hard to run like that. I had to pretend someone was pushing me from behind. The better the competition the better I run."

Now Doepke runs for the love of the sport, but a couple of years ago she took it a lot more seriously. Her injuries have made her put a hold on many goals.

"I have set goals in the past. But then when I would get injured, I would get depressed because I couldn't accomplish them," Doepke said. "It would get to me mentally."

Doepke, however, wants to make it clear that she is a competitive runner. 'I get competitive at times,'' Doepke said. ''I'm not out to get people like some runners. I'm not

into that. Maybe that hurts me, but I just run because I enjoy it. I always give it my best."

With the conference meet coming up. Madsen is hoping Doepke will be able to run. but an ACT test may prevent her from running in that meet.

"I have high hopes for her in the conference," Madsen said. "I feel she can even make it out of the regional. But I don't know if she will be able to run."

Doepke thinks she will run. "I'm sure I can arrange something with the ACT test. I'm going to talk to my counselor," Doepke said. "But if I can't I might have no other choice. I have to think of college."

The conference meet is still a few weeks away, so for the time being Doepke will just keep on running.

"When I run track I know I will have a smoother surface to run on," Doepke said. "But when I run cross country I look down to see for any pot holes. Believe me, I've hit a few of them in four years."


Time is still on the side of the Hinsdale South girls' cross country team.




At the county meet, the Hornets ran




