harriers stride for success

Girls' Cross Country

Kordewick to pace young runners

Simply put, the Hinsdale South girls' cross country team is young. About the only really experienced runner Coach Paul Madsen will have on his team is junior Kali Kordewick.

Kordewick has lettered the past two seasons and will be the individual who will have to show some leadership to a Hornet team that will be looking to her for guidance this fall season.

The Hornet harriers will begin the fall

campaign at 4:30 p.m. Thursday, Sept. 1, at Morton. At 9:30 a.m. Saturday, Sept. 3, the Hornets will be involved in the Hornet-Red Devil Invitational to be held at Katherine Legge Memorial Park in Hinsdale.

"Kali is the most experienced runner I have on the team," Madsen said. "At this point, I'm not not sure what the others can do. Only time will tell. I can tell you this, I've never had a team in the past where I didn't have at least two or three individuals that I was sure of what they could do. This year is quite different."

Missing from last year's team, due to graduation, are Rachel Doepke and Dawn Kristola, two all-conference selections. Two other runners who will be missing include Cindy Schelthoff and Jamie Morris. Both just decided not to come out again for the team.

"It will hurt not having them, but they made their decisions on what they felt would be best for them. I wish them well," Madsen said. "But this year I'm sure you will see our lineup change in attempts to find the right combinations."

Other harriers that Madsen will be looking at to back up Kordewick include a junior

transfer student from Lyons Township, Dana Kreterfield; sophomores Helga Dusek, Janet Powaga, Carolyn Siebert and Erica Ellison; and freshmen Rana Kreterfield and Sue Saxinger.

"I expect we'll get a few more out to practice this week," Madsen said. "We're far from knowing what our lineup will be. The girls I mentioned to you I know will help us, but you never know. I have some more girls trying out who I'm looking at who could contend for a position in the starting lineup."

Last season the Hornets tied with Morton for third in the Gold Division of the West Suburban Conference. "It is too bad that we open the season with Morton," Madsen said. "Since we are such a young team it would have been nice to have run against them later in the year."

Madsen feels Downers Grove South and Willowbrook will no doubt battle it out for the top spot. "I would expect both of these teams will be the ones to beat," Madsen said. "I couldn't even begin to tell you how we'll do. We're too young and have very little experience."

The opening two meets of the season will no doubt test the young Hornet harriers. "Both meets will be a challenge for us," Madsen said. "All I'm hoping for is that we can surprise some teams. We need to mature, and that will take time. Right now I have a wait and see attitude."

After an impressive 27-33 victory over Morton in their first meet last Thursday, the Hornets were looking for even better things at the Hornet/Red Devil Invite Saturday.

They didn't get what they wanted.

The Hornets were far behind the leaders at the meet and totaled 197 points. Naperville Central won with 49 points.

Erica Ellison was the Hornets' top finisher as she took 35th in 14:28. Dana Kreterfield was 37th (14:30); Carolyn Siebert was 38th (14:31); Heather Lingane followed in 39th (14:32); and Kali Kordewick was 47th (14:50).

Against Morton, the Hornets, a team that has no seniors and only 2 juniors, got good races from Kreterfield (3rd, 14:52), Siebert (4th 14:54) and Helga Dusek (5th; 15:05).

"We had a great pack - it was pretty amazing," said Coach Mike Madsen.

The Hornets travel to the Reavis Invitational Saturday.

Hinsdale South did not finish as high as Central, but Madsen was nonetheless happy with the performance of his Hornet harriers at the invitational.

"We did very well for a team with just about no experience," he said. "Most of the girls on the team had never run a high-school race before this."

The top four South runners were separated by only five seconds. Erica Ellison was 35th with a 14:28 time. Then Dana Kreterfield, Carolyn Seibert and Heather Lingane were 37th, 38th and 39th with times of 14:30, 14:31 and 14:32, respectively.

Kali Kordewick was the last scorer for the Hornets, finishing with a time of 14:50, good for 47th place. Helga Dusek was only three seconds behind in 48th place. The other varsity runner was Rana Kreterfield in 52nd place with a 15:10 time.

"We won't do well in invitationals. We don't have that front-runner to score high. If the pack keeps improving, we should be competitive in dual meets," Madsen said.

This was exemplified by South's 27-33 victory over Morton last Thursday at Morton in the West Suburban Conference (WSC) Gold

German exchange student Antje Siems improved her opening time by 45 seconds to win the race at 11:52. Other Red Devil top finishers were Becky Metz (13:18), Emily Johnson (13:45), Jenny Moran (14:06) and Tracey Truhlar (14:19).

Top Hinsdale South runners were Erica Ellison (14:28, 35th place), Dana Kreterfield (14:30), Caroline Siebert (14:31), Heather Lingane (14:32) and Kelly Kordewick (14:50).

contest. Morton won the first two places, but South took five of the next six spots.

Dana Kreterfield was third with a 14:52 time. Siebert (14:54) and Dusek (15:06) won the next two places. Seventh and eighth were Kordewick and Lingane with times of 15:19 and 15:36, respectively.

"I was very pleased to come away with a win," Madsen said. "It will take some time to develop the pack. The girls are pretty even, you are going to see a lot of different names as the season goes on."

Hinsdale South met Downers Grove South Tuesday at KLM in another conference meet. Madsen didn't expect his team to do so well because of Downers Grove's strength. The Mustangs are returning nearly all of last year's winning squad.

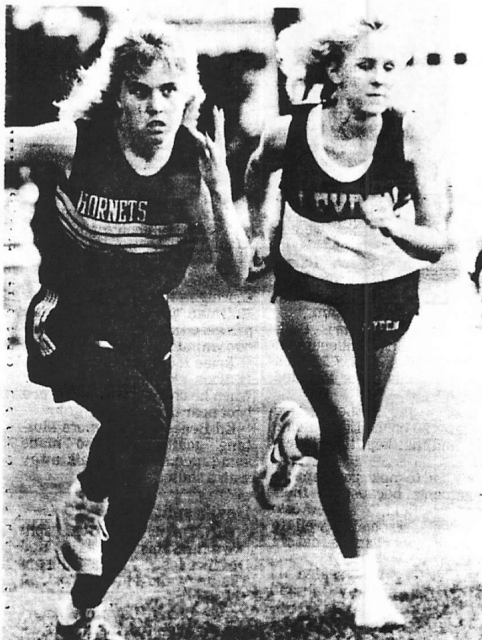
