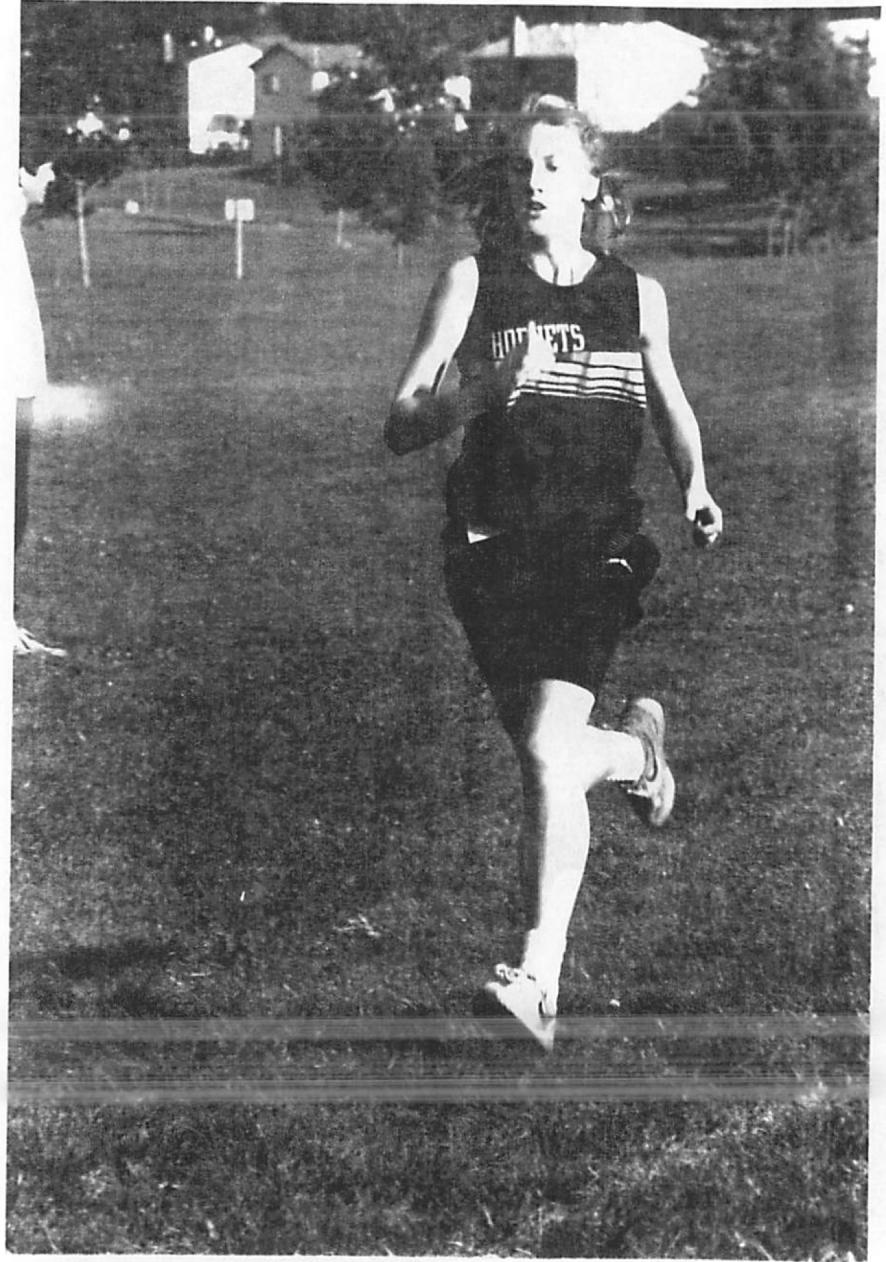

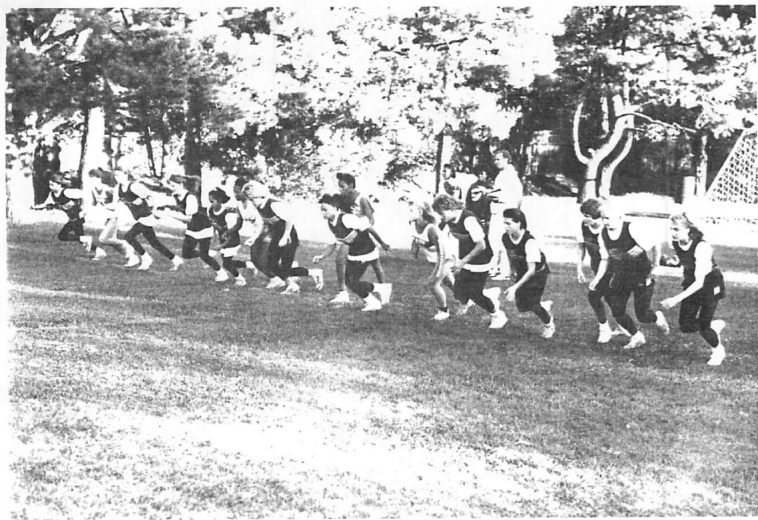

Future looks bright for both Central and South

There will be no state appearance for either the Hinsdale South Hornet or Hinsdale Central Red Devil girls' cross-country teams, but the coaches of both squads expressed encouraging thoughts about this season and the next.

The two of the Hornets, Melinda Greco and Amy Van Allen, and the entire Red Devils team participated in the state sectional meet that was held at Katherine Legge Memorial Park (KLM) in Hinsdale last Saturday morning.

Grieco finished 54th with a time of 12:48 while Van Allen finished 83rd, crossing the line at 13:12. The Devils

finished 18th overall with 453 points.

The Naperville Central Redskins won the sectional with 63 points. They placed three runners in the top eight. Redskin Tracy Tellin came in first overall with a time of 11:39.

For the Devils, Molly Metz finished 86th with a time of 13:46; Amy Doehring was 88th in 13:48; Chrysse Phillips was 132nd in 14:40; Tracey Truhlar was 135th in 14:43; Jamie Hare was 142nd in 14:51; and Molly Fournier was 154th in 15:07.

"All the girls ran a great race," Devil coach Gail Avgeris said. "Considering how young this team is I have to be encouraged by the way they ran. It was great experience for them to run in a meet

like this."

Hornet coach Mike Madsen was equally pleased with his two runners. "Each ran her best time on this course," Madsen said. "I couldn't of asked them to do any

better." Grieco improved her time at KLM by 35 seconds while Van Allen improved hers by 23 seconds.

Both runners are sophomores, so Madsen is looking forward to having them back next fall. "That will be the key for the entire program, getting them all to come back out the next season," Madsen said. "If that happens we should have a competitive team again. But I think the two girls who made it this year to sectional should feel real good about that. That isn't an easy task."

Avgeris felt the same way about her team. "You have to be honored to just have made it this far," Avgeris said. "This experience should provide us with more leadership for next season."

Sophomores Melinda Grieco, Amy Van Allen, Marjorie Larican and Rana Kreterfield recorded the top four Hinsdale South High School times to pace the team to a fifth-place finish at the Reavis Invitational last Saturday.

"This was a real nice improvement," said Coach Amy Madsen, whose team improved last year's score of 234 by almost 100 points.

Grieco was the leading runner for the Hornets crossing the finish line with a time of 14:06. Van Allen had the 21st best time overall with a 16:07 mark. Rana Kreterfield

Central, South harriers do well at state regional

It was close, but the Hinsdale Central Red Devil girls' cross country team edged out the Hinsdale South Hornets, 168 to 175, for the fifth and final qualifying spot for sectionals at the state regional meet held last Saturday at Varvic Park in Bensenville.

Because only the top five teams advance to sectionals, which is slated to begin at 10 a.m. Saturday, Oct. 28 at Katherine Legge Memorial Park in Hinsdale, all of the Devil harriers had to run their best.

The Devils had just enough points to qualify their entire team for sectional play. However, the Hornets didn't go home empty handed. Melinda Grieco (17th in 13:40) and Amy Van Allen (27th in 14:06) qualified for sectionals as individuals.

Downers Grove South won the regional with 36 points followed by York with 54, Downers Grove North with 57 and Willowbrook with 89. The battle for the fifth and final spot was fierce.

"I was never worried," Devil coach Gail Avgeris said. "I knew it would be between us, Hinsdale South and Addison Trail for that final spot. But I had a feeling by the way we were running we would come out ahead, and we did."

Emily Johnson of the Devils finished 21st overall with a time of 13:48. Devil Molly Metz came in 24th in 13:53. Amy Doehring took 35th place, crossing the line at 14:20. Jamie Hare came in 40th with a time of 14:35 and Tracey Truhlar finished 48th with a time of 15:04.

Coach Avgeris knows the next step on the Devils path to state promises to be a difficult one. "Our sectional will be like a mini-state meet," Avgeris said. "But it's

always that way each year. In past years it hasn't been unusual for the state champion to come from our sectional. But I will expect that we'll run to the best of our ability. That's all I can ask from them."

Hornet coach Mike Madsen, although disappointed that his whole team will not be going to the sectionals, will be doing his best to cheer on Grieco and Van Allen.

"The road for both of them will be very difficult," Madsen said. "You pretty much have to be all-state material to advance, but I expect both girls will give it their very best. We've got some high quality teams running in our sectional."

Madsen and his Hornet harriers were hoping to grab the final sectional spot. "Of course it would have been nice if we had finished fifth, but sixth is the best finish we've had at this school in some time in regional competition ... I can't be too disappointed."

Both Avgeris and Madsen said that running the sectional at Katherine Legge Memorial Park, both teams' home course, will give them an advantage. "You always have a better feeling running on a course that you are familiar with," Avgeris said. "I'm sure my girls will feel quite comfortable."

"The girls are more familiar with the bumps and the hills of the course," Madsen said. "I'm sure both of my girls will feel very comfortable as well."

Other Hornet runners who participated in the regional, but who didn't qualify for the sectionals, included Judy Pacubas who took 42nd place in 14:43, Sue Saxinger who finished 44th in 14:54, Rana Kreterfield who placed 45th in 14:55, Kali Kordewick who came in 53rd in 15:19 and Stephanie Swift who finished 59th in 15:51.
