"I feel that I have the best group of runners that Hinsdale South has had in some time," Madsen said. "We have some solid runners returning. It's just a matter of how they respond once the season starts."

The Hornet harriers will open their season at 9:30 a.m. Saturday, Sept. 1, at Katherine Legge Memorial Park for the Hornet-Red Devil Invitational.

"This is an unusual group in that we have no seniors running," Madsen said.

"We will be a junior-dominated squad."

Madsen has two runners, Melinda Grieco (junior) and Amy Van Allen (junior), on whom he will be counting for big things this season. Grieco and Van Allen made it to sectionals last fall.

Grieco was an all-conference selection.

Other Hornet harriers who will round out the team include Rana Kreterfield (junior), Sue Saxinger (junior), Marjorie Larican (junior), Heather Lingane (junior), Christine Laggos (junior) and Leigh Krietsch (sophomore).

Laggos as a freshman qualified for state in track in the 3,200-meter run and as a sophomore was part of the 3,200-meter relay team that qualified for state. Krietsch as a freshman won the 1,600-meter run at the conference meet and was an alternate on the state 3,200-meter relay team.

"Hopefully we can contend for the conference title," Madsen said. "It would be nice if we can give Downers Grove South (defending champs) a run for their money. We do not have any superstars on the team, but the girls we do have will do a good job. I'm looking forward to a very successful season."

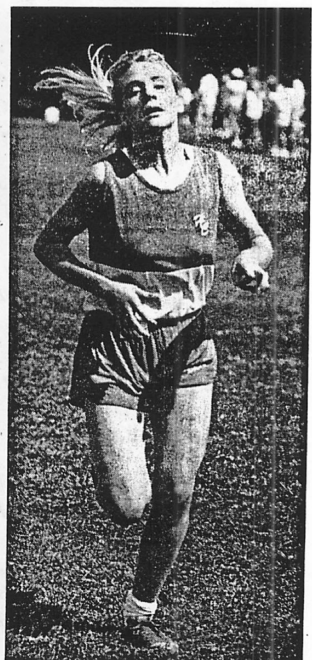

Julia Vercillo of Hinsdale Central and Rana Kreterfield of Hinsdale South sped their way to solid finishes on the cross-country course at the Hornet/Red Devil Invitational Saturday morning at Katherine Legge Memorial Park in Hinsdale.

Vercillo placed 13th overall with a time of 13:26. The Hinsdale Central Red Devils as a team finished third overall with 100 points.

Kreterfield finished 22nd overall in 13:52. The Hinsdale South Hornets placed fifth overall with 147 points. Naperville Central won the overall team trophy with 31 points.

"We ran better as a team than last year," Devils coach Gail Avgeris-Yates said. "Last year at this invite we took fifth. My top three runners are all new kids. That really pleases me."

The top Devil runners all finished in the top 35. Traci Helphrey captured 14th in 13:29. Sandra Sutor took 17th in 13:34. Colleen Haviland finished 23rd in 13:57 and Cara Croughan was 33rd in 14:23.

"The thing I really like about this team is the depth I have," Avgeris-Yates said. "My main problem is keeping them all happy."

## Cross-country

Mike

Hornets coach Paul Madsen said he felt his team gave a good showing to start the cross-country season. "We did not run great, but it was all right," Madsen said. "I'm still not sure how good we'll be, but the more experience we get I feel we'll get better. I see no reason why my top five runners can not go under 14 minutes at Katherine Legge Memorial Park. That is something we'll strive to do."

Melinda Grieco finished 26th in 14:00. Christine Laggos was 26th in 14:13. Leigh Krietsch was 32nd in 14:22. Amy Van Allen was 36th in 14:44. Sue Saxinger was 40th in 15:01 and Marjorie Larican was 64th in 16:58.

Avgeris-Yates said she was happy with the performance her junior varsity team gave Saturday. Molly Fournier came in second overall with a time of 14:06. Catherine Klimcke took seventh in 14:51.

At 4:30 p.m. Thursday, Sept. 6, the Devils will be at Katherine Legge Memorial Park for a meet against Naperville North. At 10 a.m. Saturday, Sept. 8, the Devils will be at the Proviso West Invitational.

The Hornets will compete next at 9 a.m. Saturday, Sept. 8, at the Reavis Invitational.

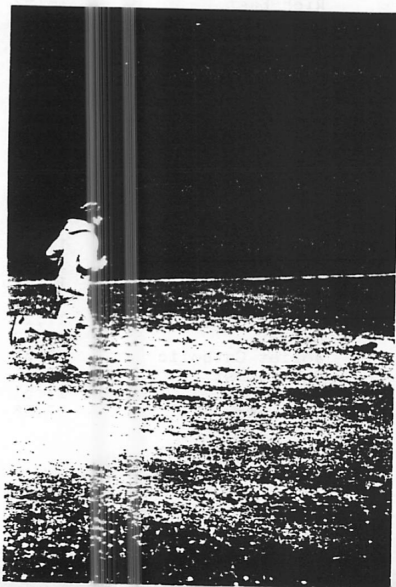

The Hornets boys' team knocked off Morton 21-35 and Proviso East 15-50 while the girls' team downed Morton 16-47 and Proviso East 15-50.

The boys' team is 5-1 in dual meets in the Gold Division of the West Suburban Conference while the girls' team is 4-2.

Rana Kreterfield finished first overall in the girls' triangular (13:07). Leigh Krietsch was third (13:22). Christine Laggos was fourth (13:50). Amy Van Allen was sixth (14:50). Glynda Davidson was eighth (14:50), Louise Nekola was ninth (14:57) and Heather Lingane was 10th (15:10).

The boys, who ran the 3.0 mile course masterfully, scored a 21-35 win over Morton, while beating Proviso East by a 15-50 margin. Leading the way for the Mustangs was Mark Michniak, who broke the tape in 17:06 and took first place overall.
