Downers Grove North not ready to throw in towel

When Erika Chesney graduated from Downers Grove North, she left a gap comparable to those she used to leave between herself and anyone who dared run against her.

Chesney, now a freshman running at Michigan State, ended her career with the Trojans with individual state championships in cross country and track.

She was only the third individual in Illinois state history to place in the top 10 at the state cross country meet all four years.

"There is no way we can replace Erika," Downers North coach Bruce Ritter said. "But I don't think we're ready to throw in the towel yet. We might have a little more than people think."

Seniors Kris Kostelny, Tosha Byrd and Laura Ziech will team up with juniors Beth Bayser and Abby Williams to give the

Trojans experience.

Other veterans expected to make contributions are seniors Karla Hanson, Tonia Byrd and Rachel Potempa and juniors Lee Kurowski, Nicole Chesney and Jamel Bean. Sophomores Helen Creagan and Rachel Nasvik also are being counted on by Ritter.

Senior Leigh Krietsch, a two-year all-West Suburban Conference Gold Division runner, is the leading returnee for Hinsdale South.

"Unfortunately Leigh is hurt," Hornet coach Mike Madsen said. "That puts a dent in things at the moment."

Krietsch finished sixth at the conference meet last year.

Other returning lettermen include senior Sarah Luetkemeyer, juniors Carlie Buenger (co-captain) and two-year letterman Glynda Davidson, and sophomore Lori Lazansky.

Sophomore Liz Reese leads

the other possible top Hornet runners. Junior Charisse Bilups, sophomore Alicia Hlustik and freshman Linda Mark also will push for the top seven spots.

Downers Grove South coach Bruce Thornquist said this is a rebuilding season for the Mustangs, but at least he has the right materials starting with all-WSC Gold runner Stephanie Contole.

Christine Danko and Amy Gonzalez are the top returning runners for Downers South.

"We're going for our 10th conference championship in a row," Thornquist said. "That's our No. 1 goal."

Jenny Rehak and Janet Cozzo also are expected to contribute, while Diana Bijon and Amy and Allison Sowell are talented freshmen.

"We've always had a real good lead runner," Thornquist said. "Someone who is all-state material. We don't have someone at that point yet. We're going to have to rely on our pack."

Hinsdale Central is led by a solid core in Molly Metz, Julia Vecello, Sandra Sutor, Colleen Haviland and Annika Culver.

"Our goal is to finish in the top five of the sectional," Hinsdale Central coach Gail Avgeris said, "and qualify for the state meet."

Tiffany Knecht, Christen Schaefer, Jill Seman and Genevive Pavden also are expected to perform well for Hinsdale Central.

Westmont's numbers increased from eight to 23 after coach Steve Wolf did some recruiting from the Sentinels'

track team.

"We're still uncertain on a few things, but it's nice to see the big numbers," Wolf said.

The top returning runner for Westmont is Julie Arseneau, who finished 23rd at last year's Class A state meet and led the Sentinels to a Southwest Suburban Conference championship.

Other keys to the Westmont team are Grace and Linda Jurkowski, Julie Jaidinger, Linda Lin and Kelly Murrey.

"We're setting our goals high this year," Wolf said. "We want to win our conference. Another goal is to make the sectional as a team. It'll be tough, but we'd like to be in there with the best of them."

Liste coach Ken Jakalski said his team needs to develop consistency.

"Last year was the first year we had a full girls team," he said. "This year, we're down a little."

Sophomore Julie Vogel will be the lead runner for the Lions this season.

"She has done very well in summertime road races," Jakalski said. "She's got a bright future."

Shana Browde, Patricia Duke, Jennifer Pasquani and Leslie Hanson will also provide some talent and leadership for the Lions.

Benet Academy coach Scott Brooks is in his first year.

"I really don't know what exactly these girls can do yet," he said. "I don't think by any means they are the upper echelon, but they'll do well. We just have to build on the past week."

The Redwings will be led by Abby Johnson and freshmen Carolyn Weirath and Audrey Segui.

"I'm pleasantly surprised with the freshman," Brooks said. "I couldn't ask for more from them."

Hinsdale South

While Hinsdale South coach Mike Madsen also has several letter winners returning to the team this fall, the Hornets' leader of the pack will be out of action for at least a portion of the season.

Leigh Krietsch, a two-year letter-winner and one of this season's co-captains, was the top runner for Hinsdale South the past two seasons. However, the senior, who earned All-West Suburban Conference Gold Division status in 1990 and 1991, has been out since early summer with a hip injury. Krietsch finished sixth at regionals last fall, helping the Hornets qualify for the sectional meet as a team.

"We don't really know how long it will be," Madsen said. "She's not even running at all right now. We hope to have her back sometime, but we really have no idea when."

Krietsch has been seeing Dr. John Durkin, who has worked with several world class runners, including 800-meter world record holder Sebastian Coe and 1992 U.S. Olympian Jim Spivey.

The Hornets' other returning two-year letterman, Glynda Davidson, will

miss the Hornets' first meet because of personal reasons. Senior Sarah Luetkemeyer, junior Carlie Bugner and sophomore Lori Lazansky, who all lettered in 1991, will make up the nucleus of Hinsdale South's varsity squad. Other varsity competitors will be junior Charisse Billups, sophomores Liz Reese and Alicia Hlustik and freshman Linda Mark.

"We do have some people with experience," Madsen said. "But we also have a lot of young and inexperienced runners. We'll just have to do what we can."

Although the Hornets failed to qualify for the state meet, they did finish third in the WSC Gold Division behind Downers Grove South and Willowbrook. Hinsdale South has never finished lower than third in the league, a tradition Madsen doesn't want to disrupt this year.

"We hope to keep that third spot or improve," Madsen said. "Downers Grove South and Willowbrook should be the teams to beat. Willowbrook has some girls that ran well in track, and Downers has a strong program and a

big school to draw from."

Both schools open their seasons Saturday, Sept. 5 with the Hornet/Red Devil Invitational at Katherine Legge Memorial Park in Hinsdale. Among the teams that will give the Hornets and Red Devils an early test are Wheaton-Warrenville South (formerly Wheaton Central) and Naperville Central.

"It should be a good meet," Avgeris-Yates said. "It will be a good way for us to start out against some competition. But not the toughest competition."

The Red Devils run against a powerful Naperville North squad on Sept. 10 at KLM, before competing in the Proviso West Invitational on Sept. 12.

Hinsdale South will compete in the Reavis Invitational on Sept. 12 before opening its conference schedule with Addison Trail on Sept. 14. The Hornets have the distinction of being the WSC Gold meet Oct. 17 at 8 M.

Buenger races to forefront of Hornets' pack

At the Reavis Invite, Buenger covered the 2.26-mile course in 15 minutes 22 seconds. As a team, the Hornets finished 10th with 234 points, though Reese and Lazansky competed on the sophomore level, where they helped their team to a fifth-place finish.

Lyons Township, led by a 1-2 finish from juniors Rebecca Teegarden and Seelye Parker, won the team title with just 22 points. Stagg (72) was a distant second, followed by Mother McAuley (101) and Argo (105).

Davidson (46th, 16:46), Billups (51st, 16:58), Michele Morgia (54th, 17:01) and Sarah Luetkemeyer (60th, 17:20) rounded out the scoring for the Hornets.

The Hornets were edged by Morton 23-32 Monday in Berwyn. The loss evened Hinsdale South's record at 3-3 on the season.

"We had high hopes going into the meet, but we didn't quite reach them," Hornet coach Mike Madsen said. "It was a close meet, closer than the score sounds. They beat us by nearly 150 points on Saturday (at the Niles West Invitational), so we were a little closer to them on Monday."

Leading the way on Monday was Liz Reese. The sophomore picked up her first varsity cross country win by covering the 2-mile course in 13 minutes 21 seconds.

Carlie Buenger was the next Hornet to enter the finish chute, placing fourth in 13:55. After a pack of

Mustangs, Hinsdale South filled five straight spots beginning with junior Charisse Billups' (14:08) eighth-place effort. Glynda Davidson, also a junior, was ninth in 14:20, while sophomore teammates Lori Lazansky (14:28), Fatima Molina (14:29) and Alicia Illustik (14:33) were 10th, 11th and 12th, respectively.

Hinsdale South dominated Morton at the junior varsity level 15-49. Senior Sarah Luetkemeyer won the race in 14:58, while freshman Linda Mark was second in 14:59 and senior Michelle Morgia was third in 15:09.

Reese's victory came despite a lingering hip injury. The sophomore was held out of the Niles West Invitational on Saturday, but the rest paid off on Monday, Madsen said.

"It was nice to see her get her first win," Madsen said. "She's been running real well for us. That's going to help us a lot at conference."

The Hornets were 20th of 30 teams in the Red Division of the Niles West Invitational with 506 points. Mother McAuley won the division with 102 points, while Sandburg took the crown in the 22-team White Division with 82 points. Morton was 12th overall in the Red Division with a score of 359.

South cross country

Buenger was the Hornets top finisher in that race, which fielded nearly 200 runners. The junior placed 59th overall, clocking a 13:31 on the 2-mile course. Davidson (99th, 13:31), Lazansky (102nd, 14:05), Billups (117th, 14:18) and Luetkemeyer (129th, 14:32) rounded out the scoring for Hinsdale South. On the junior varsity level, Molina paced the Hornets with a 16th-place effort and a time of 14:09.

The team will spend the next week training for the Oct. 17 conference meet, Madsen said. If Hinsdale South beats Morton in the league meet, the teams will wind up tied for third in the WSC Gold standings behind Downers South and Willowbrook.

Having the meet on their home course could help the Hornets in their pursuit of the Mustangs.

"Our big goal is to pass up Morton at the conference meet," Madsen said. "We've been making a lot of progress this season. The girls' times have dropped considerably this year. We'll have to have a good race to beat Morton. They've run well against us on flat courses, now we'll see who runs the best on the hills."

The third time was a charm for the Hinsdale South girls' cross country team on Saturday.

Senior Sarah Luetkemeyer was next for the Hornets, finishing 25th in 14:09, while teammates sophomore Lori Lazansky (26th, 14:11), junior Charisse Billups (28th, 14:20), junior

Glynda Davidson (30th, 14:23) and sophomore Fatima Molina (31st, 14:25) were close behind.

Although the Hornets had only raced at Katherine Legge twice this season prior to Saturday, having the conference meet on their home course helped the Hornets, Madsen said.

"That was probably the one extra advantage that we had that worked in our favor," Madsen said. "It helped us a lot."

Hinsdale South also was third on the junior varsity level. Downers South posted a perfect score of 15, followed by Willowbrook (52) and the Hornets (63). Morton (120) was the only other team to field a full team.

Linda Mark (seventh, 14:26) was the top JV runner for Hinsdale South, and was joined by teammates Rachel Folk (10th, 14:33), Alicia Hlustik (12th,

"There will be a group duking it out for fifth place," Madsen said of the regional. "It will be difficult for us because we're definitely in the toughest regional of that sectional, and there are some good teams there. We'll just have to give it our best shot."

Reese covered the wooded 2-mile course in a personal-best time of 12 minutes, 51 seconds. Buenger, despite fighting a lingering cold, finished in 13:13 to earn the final individual qualifying spot. Joliet West's Michelle Bozue took the individual honors in 12:03.

Glynda Davidson (13:43) narrowly missed advancing to the sectional with a 37th-place effort. Teammates Alicia Hlustik and Rachel Folk, who were the Hornets' ninth and 10th runners last week at the West Suburban Conference Gold Division Meet, placed fourth and fifth, respectively, for the Hornets on Saturday. Hlustik (13:53) took 40th place, while Folk (14:02) was 44th to round out Hinsdale South's team score.

Hinsdale South's Lori Lazansky finished 52nd in 14:28 despite suffering from an injured knee, while

Charisse Billups placed 53rd in 14:31.

"I was really pleased with the kind of running the girls turned in," Madsen said. "Even under perfect conditions, it would have been tough for us to get out. We're really pleased that Carlie and Liz qualified."

"As long as you're in the sectional meet, you've got a chance."

Hornets' Reese, Buenger fall short at Lincoln-Way

Liz Reese nearly pulled it off.

The Hinsdale South sophomore, in her first year of cross country, narrowly missed qualifying for the Nov. 7 state meet in Peoria by running the race of her life on Saturday at the Lincoln-Way Sectional in New Lenox.

Reese finished 15th in the 2-mile sectional race in a personal best time of 12 minutes, 38 seconds. The sophomore narrowly missed qualifying for state because she was the 11th individual competitor to enter the finish chute in the 160-runner race. Only the top five teams and the top seven individuals not on those teams qualify for state. The seventh individual on Saturday placed 10th overall.

"Liz ran an absolutely fabulous race," Hinsdale South coach Mike Madsen said. "That's the first time I've ever seen a sectional where a runner has to be in the top 10 to make it down state. But that doesn't take away from the race she ran. She ran exceptionally well for us."

Unfortunately for Reese's teammate Charlie Buenger, things didn't go quite as well. The junior was feeling very under the weather and could not per-

form at her usual level. Buenger, who was consistently one of the top two runners for the Hornets all season, finished in 100th place in 13:58.

"Charlie was quite sick. If it had been any other race I would have told her not to bother to run," Madsen said. "But she went out and gave it her best shot. It was tough for her though."

Reese and Buenger had each qualified for the sectional after finishing among the top five individuals in the Sandburg Regional on Oct. 24. As a team Hinsdale South finished a non-qualifying sixth place.

Madsen said among the keys to Reese's effort were a more aggressive start and her determination throughout the race. And, strangely enough, it was also the first race Reese wore spikes in a race.

"She really came on for us in the second half of the season," Madsen said. "I had this wild hope that she'd make it. Hopefully the experience will pay off next year."

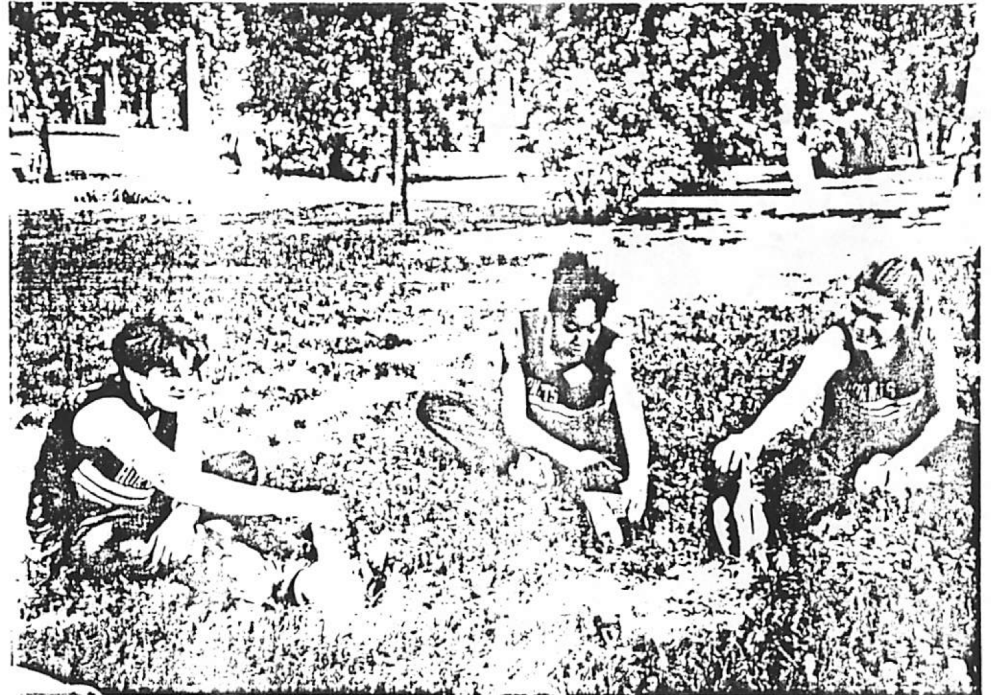
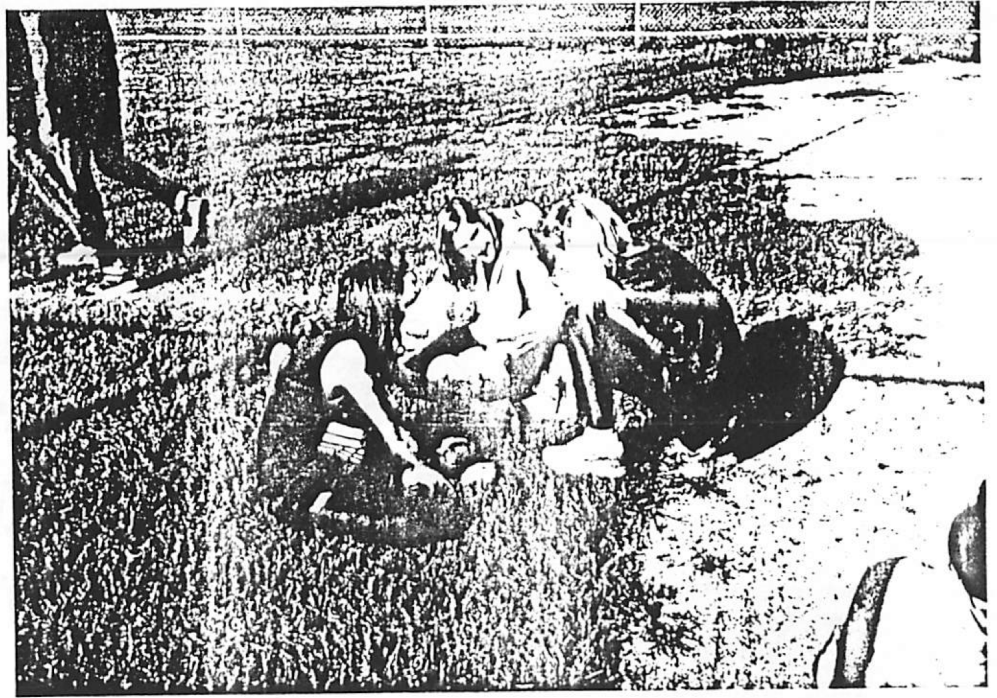

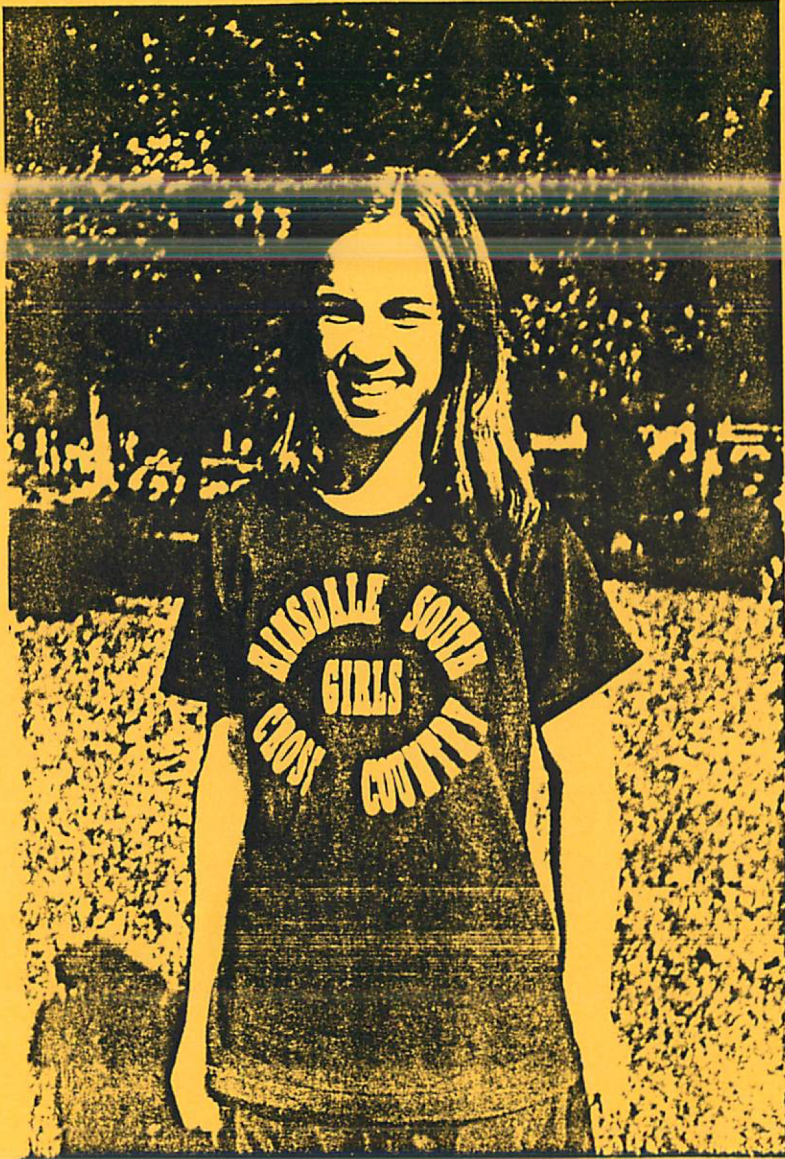
