Three good showings?

With two good invitational showings so far, Hinsdale South's cross country team will try to extend it to three when it competes in the Reavis Invitational this Saturday, Sept. 17.

Last week the Hornettes finished fourth in the St. Charles Invitational behind such powers as Palatine, Schaumburg and St. Ignatius.

South might have done better, but its top runner, Eileen Slowikowski, was feeling the effects of a cold and finished fourth with a time of 10:29

The first three finishers broke the course record she set last year.

Still, Coach Mike Madsen was pleased with his team's showing

"Palatine and Schaumburg are two of the top teams in state," he said: "Most of the times were better than last year, although it was hot. Last year we went away unhappy with what we did at this meet. We didn't want that to happen again."

The Hornettes spread their runners out evenly, although the second through fifth runners were all within a minute of each other. Finishing behind Slowikowski were Sally Kurth (15th, 11:13); Carrie Faber (18th, 11:19); Karyn Verdak (28th, 11:37); and Diane Sly (35th, 11:57).

Jackie Smalley finished 20th in an open race (12:47).

Madsen has been pleased with the performances of Faber and Sly, who are running for the first time.

"Carrie has been getting better with each race, and Diane has been a pleasant surprise," Madsen said. "I didn't think she would help us nearly as much as she has."

Madsen would like the services of freshman Kerri Hughes, who is out with a hip injury right now. He expects her back sometime in October.

Meanwhile, the Hornettes are sporting more power than last year. They already have improved a place in each invitational. Madsen hopes the team will perform well at Reavis, where it finished fifth last year.

"The girls like to run that meet," he said.
"They give a lot of medals and trophies.
That's a good incentive. We'd like to get a trophy."

On Monday, Sept. 19, South will have its first conference meet against Addison Trail and Riverside-Brookfield at Katherine Legge Park.
