

## Devils' pack picks up slack; Hornet trio shines

Hinsdale Central girls' cross country coach Gail Avgeris knew she would have to fill some fast shoes on Saturday at the Downers Grove South Mustang Run.

Specifically the spikes of Colleen Haviland and Christen Schaefer, two of the Red Devils' top five runners, who are both sidelined with injuries.

Anne Seliga and Lisa Warner stepped into those shoes and found a comfortable fit. The Hinsdale Central duo finished as the team's third and fourth runners, respectively, and helped the Red Devils to a third-place finish in the eight-team meet.

"I was very pleased with how we did considering we were missing two of our top runners," Avgeris said. "It was nice to have some of the girls feel they have to fill in."

Sandra Sutor was once again the top individual finisher for the Red Devils, placing third in 12 minutes, 32 seconds. She finished behind Naperville North standouts Kim Malmquist (12:19) and Kristin Devaney (12:20).

"I know she was hoping to beat them, but I thought she did OK," Avgeris said. "She went out a bit fast at first and I think the Naperville girls used her to set the pace."

Also turning in a top 10 performance on Saturday was junior Colleen Kula, who finished in 13:20. Seliga (14th, 13:59), Warner (17th, 14:03) and Jill Seman (26th, 14:31) all helped pick up

the slack for the Red Devils.

Naperville North won the meet with 20 points, and the host Mustangs (60) edged Hinsdale Central (66) for second.

Hinsdale Central lost its first West Suburban Conference Silver Division dual meet 25-30 to Oak Park on Sept. 16. Sutor was the individual winner in 12:39 and was followed by Kula (4th, 13:03), Seliga (7th, 13:30), Bottger (8th, 13:59) and Seman (10th, 14:00).

### Hinsdale South

Hinsdale South competed in the Minooka Invitational on Saturday. In that meet each of the team's seven runners ran in a separate flight of the 2-mile race.

The Hornets didn't record a team score because they didn't have seven runners finish, but Liz Reese, Erica Coull-Parenty and Rachel Folk all shined. Reese placed eighth in the top flight in 13:21, while Coull-Parenty (13:07) and Folk (13:51) were each third in the second and third flights, respectively.

Jenny Peterson also ran well for the Hornets, taking sixth in the fourth flight in 14:53.

Sandwich won the meet with 12 points, followed by Bradley (18), Herscher (24) and East Aurora (28).
